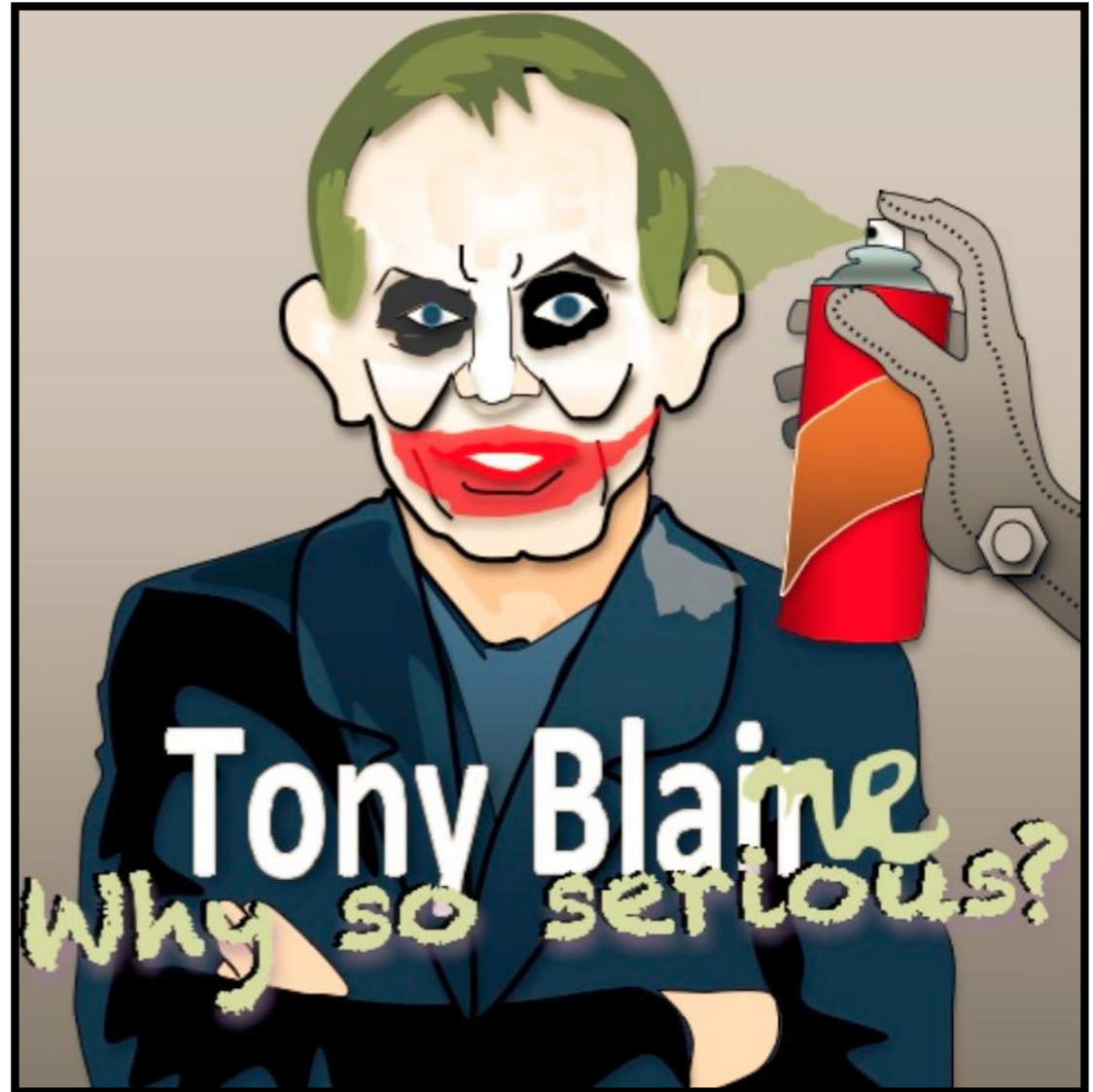
**Creative is as creative does**

- 4. THE ANSWER COMES FROM CLARIFYING A PROBLEM THAT WAS ORIGINALLY VAGUE**

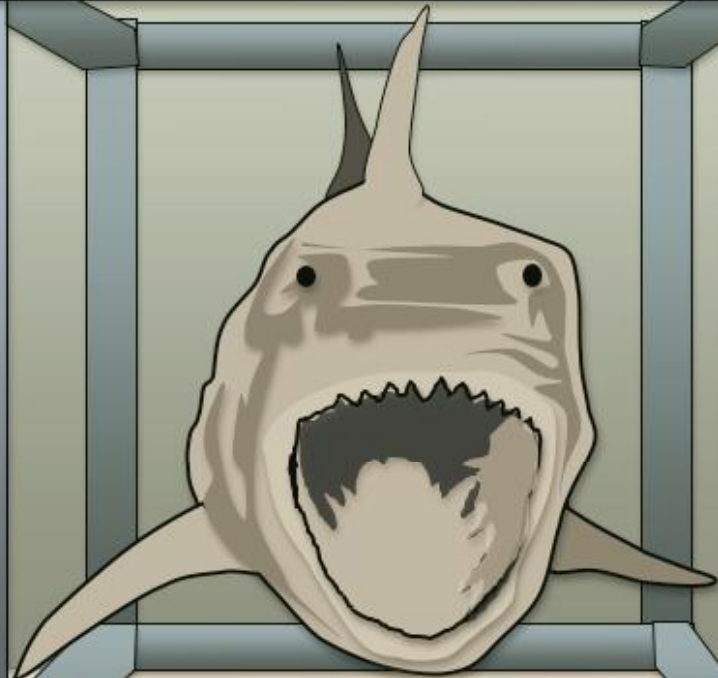

Convergence toward a single viewpoint and a consensus answer.

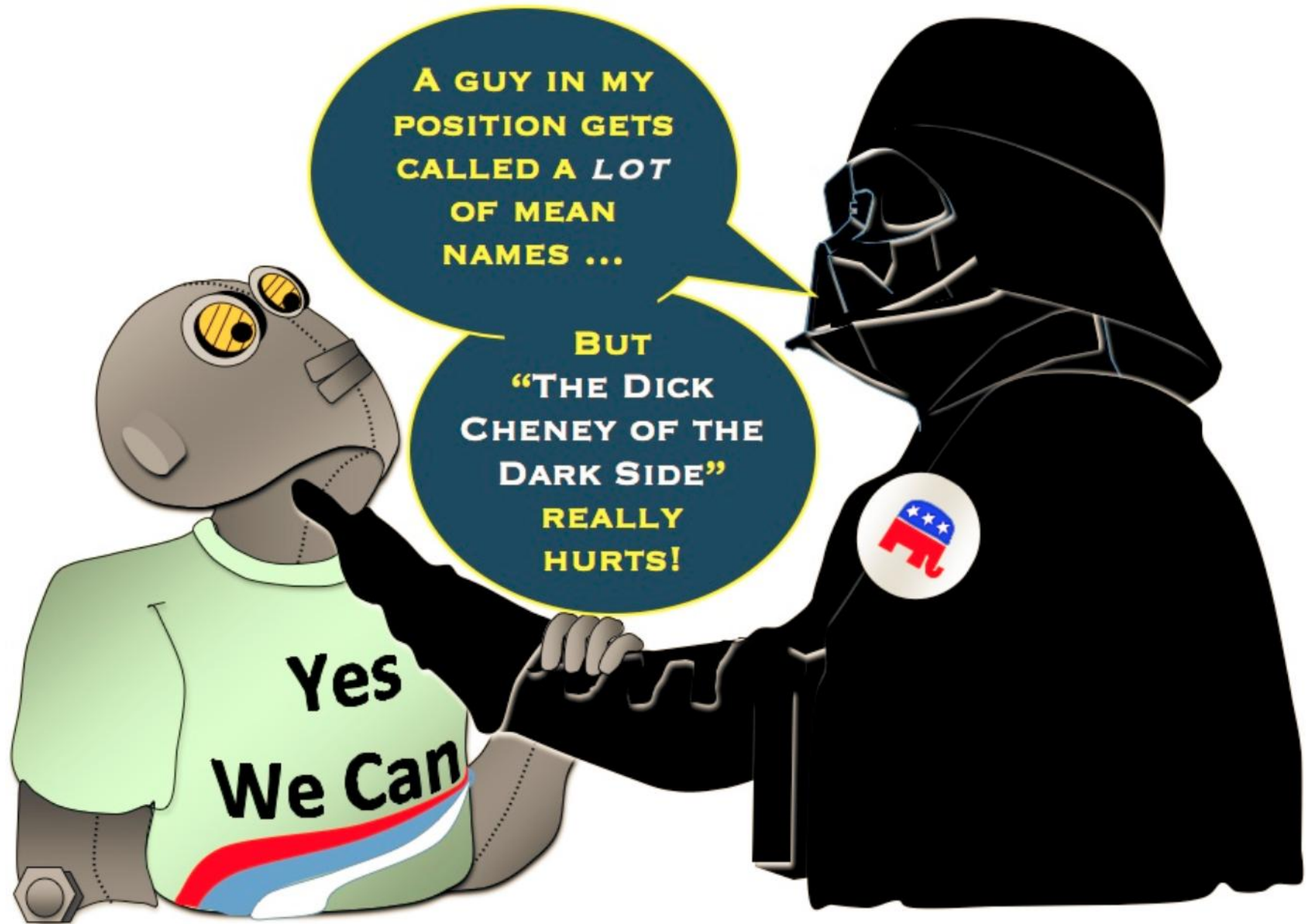
## Divergent Thinking

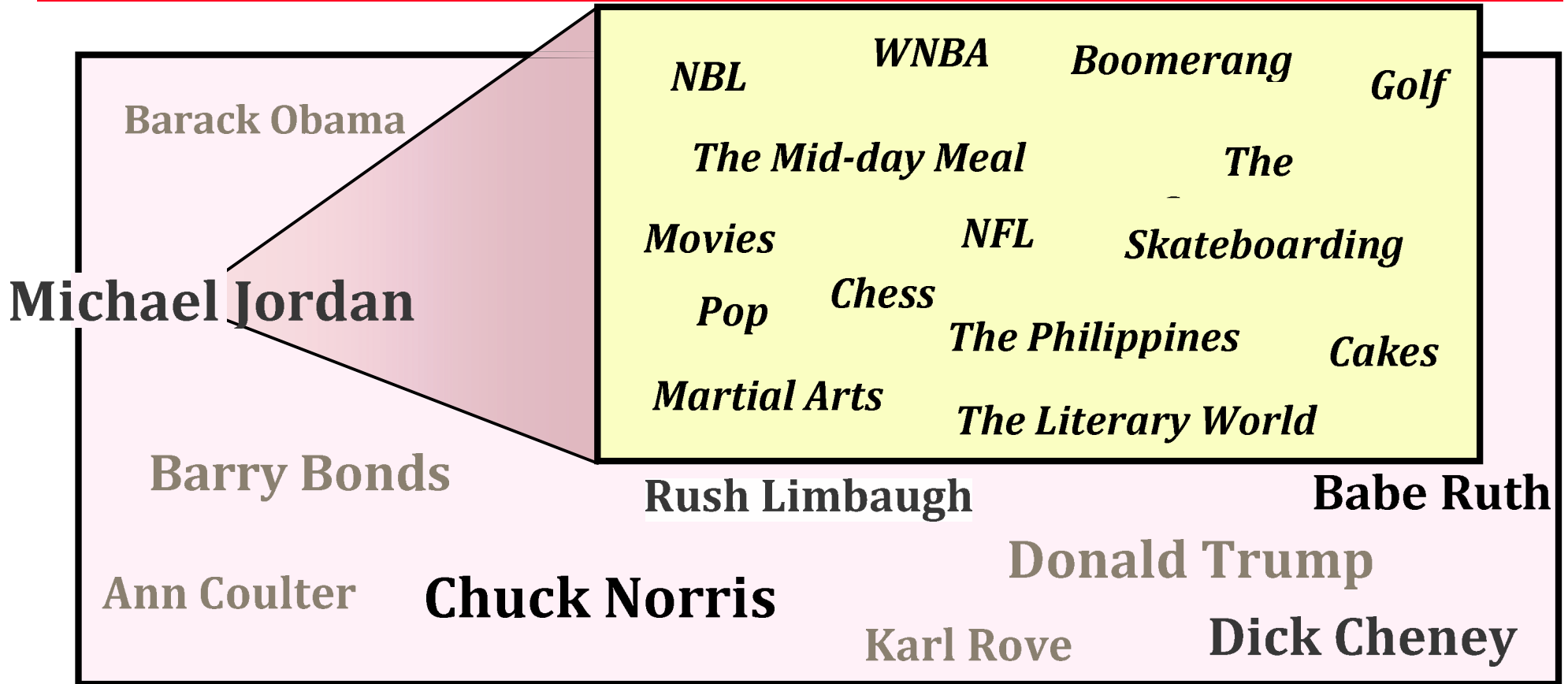

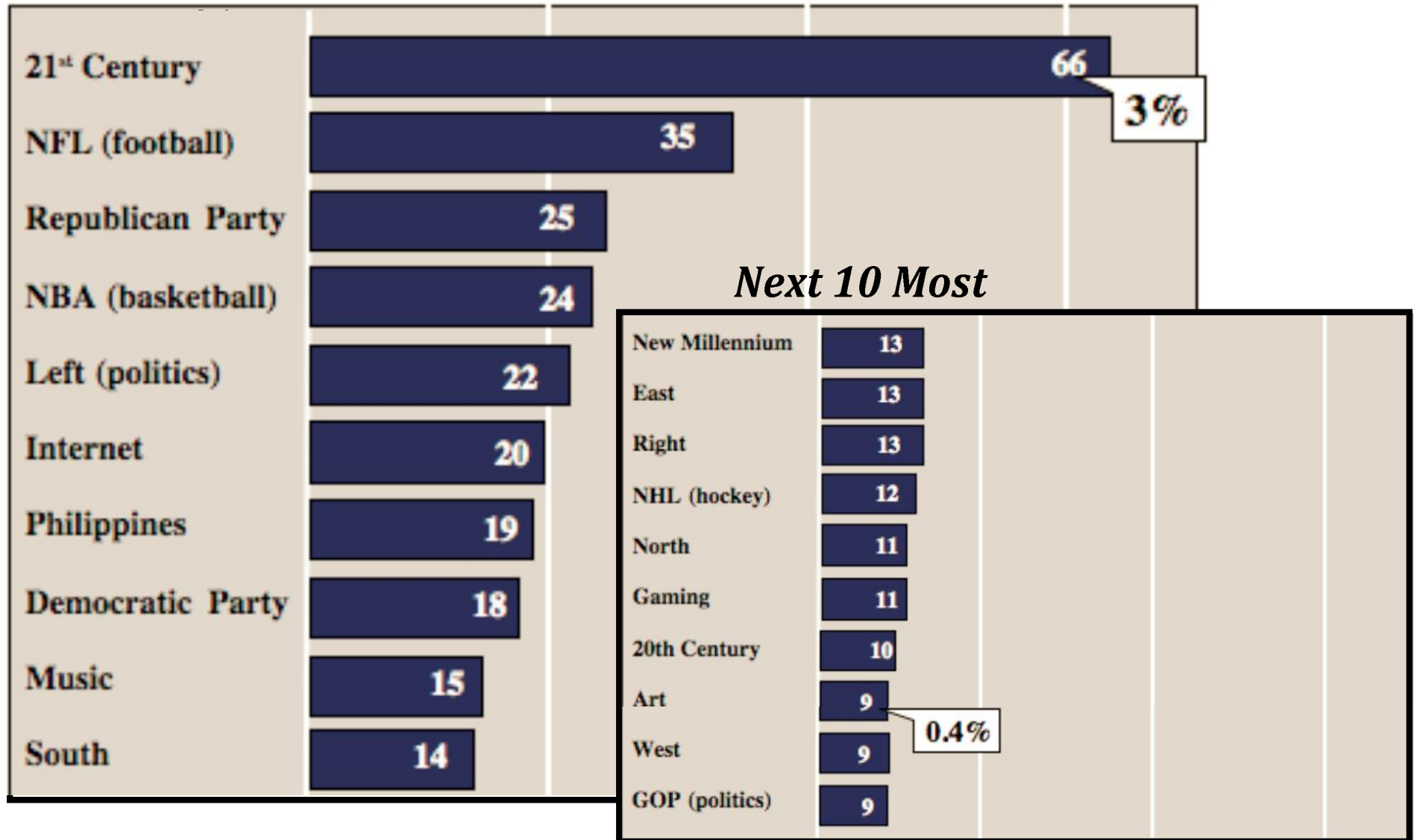

## An Inventory of Vivid Topics: Used to build Creative Comparisons

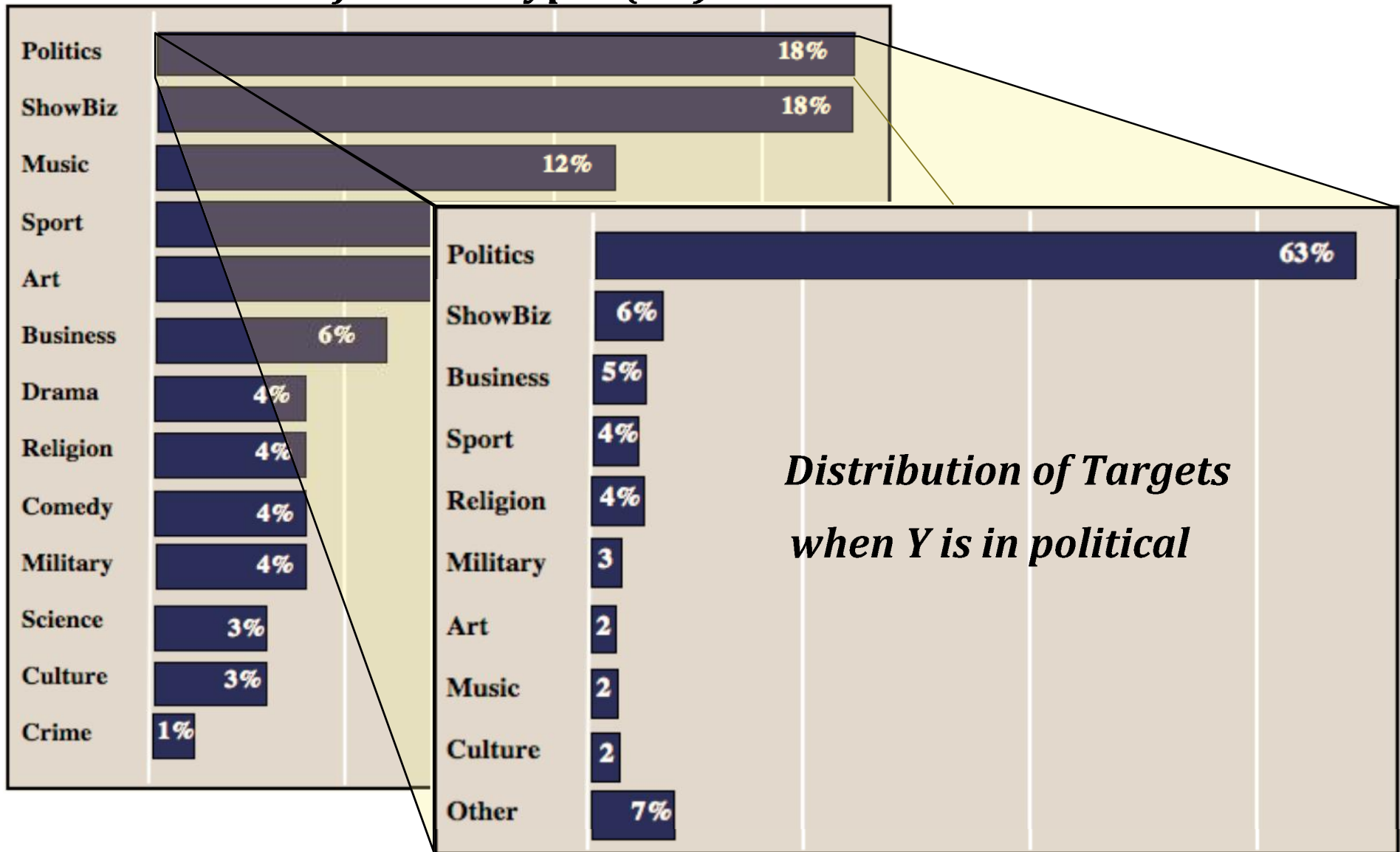
