Approbatur and Laudatur practically never given

Grade 4 or better requires "own contribution", usually meaning "do something for real"

Language must be excellent for top grades

Grading Criteria

- Topic area
 - Outlining problem, methods, etc.
- Command of whole thesis
 - Knowledge of field, organization
- Representation
 - Presentation, language
- Overall impression

Supervisor's Role

- Only one supervisor
 - Two people will read and grade your thesis
- Supervisor helps you get through the thesis
 - "Prevent you from sinking"
- Supervisor does not care about what grade you want to have
 - Your own ability determines your grade
 - Supervisor's goal is to give guidance for finishing
- No iterating for a better grade
